#### CompassLearning Getting Started

- Download the Puffin Academy app on your school iPad
- Bookmark [www.TheLearningOdessey.com](http://www.TheLearningOdessey.com) and <https://www.khanacademy.org/>
- Log into CompassLearning using your school-assigned login and password
- Login to CompassLearning:
  - User Name: your initials and lunch number (nc12345)
  - Password: eanes123
  - School: Type in “**Eanes**” instead of “ODYSSEY”
- If the option appears, tap/click on “CompassLearning” (not Odyssey High School).
- Work will appear for you, and you must complete it in the order provided for you.

**Credit Recovery** is a self-paced program that allows students to gain needed credits in a variety of subjects for graduation.

All courses begin with at least 1 **Pre-Test** that covers all content in a given course. It is in a student’s best interest to prepare for the Pre-Test and do the best that s/he can on it because passing a pre-test with a 70+ means that

- you do not have to complete the modules/activities that follow
- *unless you want to do it to try for a higher grade*

AND, even if you do not pass the entire pre-test with a 70+, any concepts/material that you do pass within the pre-test eliminate some of the course work that you would otherwise have to do. The higher you score, the less work you have to do.

# Westlake High School - Credit Recovery

## Expectations and Norms

- All students will respect all students, teachers, property, and school expectations
- All students will remember that Credit Recovery is a privilege & will act accordingly
- All students will allow others a quiet and positive work environment
- Students will only log in to their own personal Compass Learning accounts and will maintain the integrity of the program by working only on their assigned courses
- All students will ask before leaving the classroom
- Pre-tests
  - Cannot be taken until given permission by Credit Recovery Teacher.
  - Are not open-note or open resources- pretests must be completed by a single student using only their knowledge. Calculators and formula sheets may be allowed.
  - Must be taken at school, under Credit Recovery Teacher's supervision or in the Testing Center.
  - Students who earn a 70+ on the Pre-Test will not need to complete any additional coursework to earn credit for that portion of their course credit, so some extra effort with studying before you start can have a big payoff for you.
  - Pre-tests taken that do not meet the above standards will be discarded and will not count toward credit.
- Do not run other programs or websites not associated with CompassLearning during class time unless given previous explicit permission by teacher. This includes music and chat sites.
- Students will not have out technology that is not being used for educational purposes.
- Students must sign-in to CompssLearning daily and should report any hardware problems with your technology immediately to the classroom teacher.
- You must maintain an average of 70% on course work, and any work that causes you to fall below that average must be redone or credit cannot be regained.

## **More Expectations and Norms**

- All assignments should be completed through CompassLearning.
- Students will meet periodically with Credit Recovery teacher to discuss status, goals, and incentives (these will be decided and carried out on an individual basis).
- Any students wanting to complete work outside of school hours may do so on their own technology (except Pre-Tests & Lesson Quizzes that may be done in the Testing Center).
- Credit Recovery Teachers will be available during school hours through email or conference; any communication received outside of the school day will be returned during the next school day.

- Credit Recovery Tutoring
  - Core Classes have free tutors in the Library 4 days per week
    - take advantage of this and see a teacher for your course's content
    - check announcements & postings for specific days & times
- Supplies needed daily (mandatory for success)
  - Personal headphones
  - School issued iPad, charged & functional
  - Personal journal, notebook, or binder w/ paper to write on with a writing utensil
  - Calendar/Agenda (optional)
- Tardy Policy
  - Students must have a pass from the office to enter
  - When you arrive tardy to class, quietly take out your materials, put your personal belongings away, and take your seats
  - Do not interrupt the class in order to explain your tardiness
